T Sport Bernau is strongly committed to reducing the environmental impact of its operations and adhering to sustainable practices by collaborating with our team members, partners, and the championship promoter to make the team more sustainable.

Within this Policy, we have outlined our sustainability actions in order to reduce the environmental impact of the team whilst competing in the Goodyear FIA European Truck Racing Championship.

We are a professional, young, and forward-thinking truck racing team that recognises the growing importance of sustainability, not only within motorsport, but also across the wider automotive, commercial vehicle, and transport industries worldwide.

We strive to continually improve year on year through the use of the best available and economically feasible technologies.

To reduce the environmental impact of our activities and operations, we are committed to:

- Reducing the CO₂ footprint created by our activities, with particular focus on the logistics of our operations, combined with running our race truck on 100% renewable biofuel.
- Monitoring energy usage and ensuring our workshop uses 100% green electricity.
- Sourcing local and environmentally friendly products and materials wherever possible.
- Educating and motivating team members to carry out tasks in an environmentally responsible manner.
- Focusing on reducing waste and maximising recycling wherever possible.
- Reducing water usage by collecting and using rainwater at our workshop.
- Working with partners and contractors who share our environmental values and collaborate with us to achieve our objectives.
- Protecting the environment, including preventing pollution and fulfilling other specific commitments relevant to the context of the organisation.
- Organising joint transport to events for team members and informing guests about public transport options.
- Complying with all relevant environmental legislation, regulations, and compliance obligations.

We provide a framework for setting and monitoring our environmental objectives.

Environmental Objectives for 2026

- To reduce carbon emissions associated with travel by 4%.
- To reduce the use of harsh wheel-cleaning chemicals by 80%.
- To increase sustainable clothing practices by reusing 100% of 2025 team clothing for the 2026 season.
- To ensure at least 70% of outbound parcels use reused packaging materials.
- To support lower-emission logistics solutions through our DHL GoGreen shipping partnership.
- To increase waste recycling at events through the implementation of a waste separation system.
- To achieve net zero emissions by 2030.

We also actively work with and support the FIA and race circuits in their efforts to improve sustainability and reduce environmental impact.

We ask for everyone's collaboration and support as we continue to drive our commitment to sustainability and environmental responsibility forward.
