POLICY STATEMENT

T Sport Bernau is committed to reducing the environmental impact of its operations by collaborating with our team members, partners and the championship promotor to make the team more sustainable. In this document we would like to outline the actions we take in order to reduce the environmental impact of our race team whilst competing within the FIA European Truck Racing Championship.

We are a professional, young and forward-thinking truck racing team who appreciate the rising importance of sustainability both within motorsport and the wider automotive, commercial vehicle and transport industries.

We have already made several changes to our operations in order to become more environmentally friendly and we strive to continue to make more changes in the future based on the best available and economically feasible technology available.

To reduce the environmental impact of our activities and operations, T Sport Bernau is committed to:

- x Reduce the CO2 footprint created by our activities, with particular focus on the logistics of our operation combined with running our race truck on 100% renewable biofuel
- x Monitor the use of energy and make sure our workshop is using only 100% green electric
- x Educate and motivate employees and team members to carry out tasks in an environmentally responsible manner
- x Focus on recycling waste
- x Reduce water usage by collecting and using rain water at our workshop

Our focus in the future is to:

- x Improve and monitor our activities with relation to sustainability
- x Promote awareness of environmental issues by planning actions together with our partners
- x Focus on reducing waste both in our workshop and at the race circuit
- x Increase use of environmentally friendly products in the catering / hospitality area

We will also actively work with and support our promotor ETRA who are working towards net zero emissions in our championship by 2038.

This sustainability policy and the achievement of the established goals will be reviewed periodically.
